HISTORICAL CRAFTS/SKILLS

Ages: 6 - 9

Tailored to the age of your group and may consist of activities such as:

- Yarn Dolls

- Slates and chalk

HERITAGE FIBER ARTS

Ages: 9 & up

Tailored to the age of your group and may consist of activities such as:

- Wool carding
- Weaving
- Spool knitting
- Crocheting
- Rug hooking
- Braiding
- Knitting

LOG CABIN BUILDING

Blocks shaped like logs are used to build buildings. This is intended as a group activity, there will be nothing to take home.

ROPE MAKING SKILLS

Children will learn the history of rope, the craft of rope making and the contribution rope has made to the development of civilization. The children will operate a rope making machine, with supervision.
