

Disclaimers and Disclosures

The Vintage Veterinary Exhibit Association (“VVEA”) is the name of the charitable organization making the solicitations. VVEA is a corporation incorporated under the Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act (Canada). Its address is Suite 2400, 525 8th Avenue SW, Calgary, AB T2P 1G1. Contributions will be used to:

- i. fund, design, construct, develop, operate and maintain a vintage veterinary exhibit to be located at Heritage Park in Calgary, Alberta,
- ii. develop an interpretive program for the exhibit, and
- iii. recruit and train volunteers to participate in the operation of the exhibit.

VVEA requires \$225,000 to complete both phases of the project; \$150,000 for phase one and \$75,000 for phase 2.

\$112,000 of the phase one \$150,000 is needed to begin building the exhibit within the livery stable but the full amount of the phase 2 \$75,000 must be raised to develop the horse and carriage live exhibit. We cannot proceed with phase 2 until the \$150,000 of phase one has been raised. This phase 2 part can be developed at a later date if necessary. We have three years to raise the money.

Although it is the intention to use the funds raised to support the establishment and operation of the exhibit at Heritage Park, if insufficient monies are raised or the project is terminated, the funds raised (including your donation) will not be returned or refunded and would be used by Heritage Park to support its livestock program by providing care to the horses and other livestock, purchasing livestock and delivering interpretive ranching and farming programs for Heritage Park’s purposes. None of the contributions raised will be used to pay the costs of making the solicitations.
